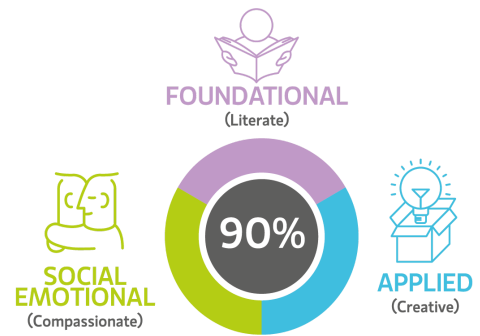
MOONSHOT ENRICHED LITERACY CERTIFICATION



WHY: To cultivate compassionate, creative, literate citizens who will improve our world.

HOW: Enriched Literacy is defined as having 3 key components: Social Emotional Literacy, Foundational Literacy, and Applied Literacy. Enriched Literacy is always anchored and connected through rich text.

- **Social Emotional Literacy:** the ability to manage emotions and navigate group interactions to build a community of learners. *How do we create the conditions in which students are safe and available to learn?*
- **Foundational Literacy:** the ability to read words and bring meaning to text. *What are the essential skills students need to learn to be able to read?*
- **Applied Literacy:** the ability to apply skills and knowledge gained to authentic, real-world contexts. *How do we create authentic opportunities for students to show what they know and apply their learning?*

DETAILS:

To be eligible for the Moonshot Practitioner Certification, candidates need to complete three steps in a professional learning cycle:

1) LEARN

- **25 hours of training in a shared learning experience.**

Each of the 10 modules is a 2.5 hour workshop.

2) DO

- **Implementation through micro-credentials**

Each Micro-credential includes specific best practice strategies from the workshops that can be implemented in a classroom or after school program, as well as additional research and background to support each module. You will have access to coaching and support throughout the implementation process, to be shaped to your individual needs. The Bloomboard platform provides an easy way to share evidence of implementation.

3) REFLECT

- **15 hours of participation in a professional learning cohort.** This can be completed in one of two ways:
 - a) Participate in a series of Moonshot Mondays (7 dates in the 2018-19 school year)
 - b) Participate in a virtual PLC hosted on Zoom

The Learning Alliance is growing a Moonshot Literacy Corps through this Moonshot Curriculum to ensure that schools have the well trained resources they need to support students through extended learning opportunities (in school, after school and in the summer). These resources currently include:

- Interventionists
- Moonshot K-2 Literacy Coaches
- Moonshot Academy Facilitators
- Moonshot Academy Teachers
- Moonshot Innovation Specialists

NOTE: Over time, we will develop and add additional micro-credentials and workshops targeted at next level practitioners. Educators can become a Moonshot Master Practitioner (201) and a Moonshot Master Coach (301).
