







<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Most common syllable type: 43% of English words • Exceptions include patterns such as: all, ind, old, ost, ild, olt • Taught in K without talking about syllable type • Mastered in 1st, Reviewed in 2nd 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Has only 3 letters; a consonant an l and an e • The e is the vowel. • Pronounced with consonant sound and /ul/ • It is the last syllable in a word. • Exceptions: tle the t is silent. castle. • Taught & mastered in 2nd (last unit) 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Has only 1 vowel • Vowel sound is long • Approximately 29% of English words • Exceptions: a A las ka ka bob i com pli ment in di cate • Introduced in 1st, mastered in 2nd 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two vowels together that make one sound • Some consonants team up with vowels such as y, w, gh (ow, ey, ay, oy, ew, aw, igh, eigh, ough) • Some teams make more than one sound: snow, plow • Ex: 2 vowels together are not always a team: vi o lin • Introduced in 1st, mastered in 2nd • Harder for spelling than reading 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Has a vowel, then a consonant, then an e • First vowel is long • e is silent • Mastered in 1st, Reviewed in 2nd • Exceptions: the letter v give vowel is still short (2nd) 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Has 1 vowel followed by an r • Vowel sound is neither long or short • Exceptions: vowel followed by a double r: merry • Ex: or & ar in a final syllable: tractor • Introduced in 1st, mastered in 2nd 	

A syllable is a word or part of a word. It must have at least one vowel. It may or may not have consonants before or after the vowel.
