Framing Question:

What does it take to create literate, compassionate, creative citizens who improve our world?

The classroom supports the **social-emotional needs** of the child. Learning happens **collaboratively** in an environment **safe to take risks**.

All students are **engaged** in a **reading environment** rich with **multi-sensory experiences** around **complex texts**.

Ongoing **reflection**, **assessment and documentation** makes deep learning and thinking **visible**, **inspiring curiosity and creativity**.

Language and curriculum in the classroom foster vigorous thinking and inquiry. Students demonstrate passion for content and a desire to continue learning.

The physical environment is **aesthetically rich** with meaningful print and visual texts, student work, and spaces for differentiated learning.

Learning is integrated and connected. Meaningful connections are made between students lives, content areas, and the larger community and world.

Curriculum supports the **foundational literacy needs** of the student which include reading, writing, and speaking, as well as connections through **applied comprehension**.
