Time & Facilitator	Procedure	Materials
6 minutes	 Write & Reflect Activity Students pair up with their Closed Syllable or V-E partner, talk about the word. Write in their journals a sentence using that word with an illustration 	Word Cards Journal
10 minutes	 Level 3 Mastery Activity Students will be given a small piece of text to read and annotate details in the text to write in their graphic organizer (GO) Pictures will surround the room. Students will match the text to one of the pictures. Then write the details of their picture in their GO. Students leave the text that has their number on it with the picture. They go back to their desk, finish their graphic organizer by adding a title of the invention they read about. Paste GO in their Words of Wisdom section 	Text Pictures Boards Easels Journals Glue Scissors
15 minutes	 Collaborative Activity (Teacher will monitor conversations and ask stem questions - formative assessment) Students will go back to their invention piece with the other students that had the same writing. They will discuss how they knew the illustration went with their text They will also discuss how the illustration helped them understand what they read Students will share their titles with the group. Then they will pick one to share out with the group and share the invention. 	Stem Questions
